

Movie: Waterloo Bridge (by Vivien Leigh and Robert Taylor) (1940)

Waterloo Bridge is a 1940 remake of the 1931 film also called *Waterloo Bridge*, adapted from the 1930 play *Waterloo Bridge*. In an extended flashback narration, it recounts the story of a dancer and an army captain who meet by chance on Waterloo Bridge. The film stars Robert Taylor and Vivien Leigh, her first film after the success of *Gone with the Wind*. The film was a success at the box office and nominated for two Academy Awards—Best Music for Herbert Stothart and Best Cinematography. It was also considered a personal favourite by both Vivien Leigh and Robert Taylor.
